

Bay Area AI TV (~30-minute Pilot) is a groundbreaking experimental community TV show - **designed, written, and executed locally**, an *incubator for alt-reality: present, past, and future* - that fuses algorithmic creativity with community engagement and Bay Area counterculture. Engineered by the enigmatic “secret tablet” that writes the prompts, the series transforms each week’s content - *including news, events, places, and ideas*—into a multimedia tapestry powered by artificial intelligence and hosted by veteran creative William Paul (willipaulstudio.com, planetshifter.com). The show features a rotating showcase of local advertisers and spotlights.

Bay Area AI TV - Pilot is both **a media experiment and a living laboratory** - an invitation to participate, prompt, and remix content in real time. Staged for pilot production at a community studio and infused with the Bay Area’s experimental spirit, the show proposes a *new kind of local television*, where artificial intelligence, creative humans, and community narratives converge. Unlike derivative Silicon Valley parodies or closed creative ecosystems, Bay Area AI TV is community-rooted, experimental, and participatory.

Script Outline for Bay Area AI TV - Pilot version 2.0

AIGC: Artificial Intelligence Generated Content

Pre-programmed text / video / image— Where final content and associated prompts are provided ahead of time. This ensures quality content for viewers. This process will be mentioned in the credits (Segment Eight).

Tablet is a visual prop, a tool that initiates the prompts.

Location: Editing Room - Internet & Monitor

Segment One: Title, logo (see next page), introduction text. Text on thumb drive.

Segment Two: Event Announcement*- prompt via tablet. AIGC. Prompt on thumb drive.

Segment Three: Poetry - prompt via tablet. Pre-programmed text on thumb drive.

Segment Four: News - prompt via tablet – City of Monterey Jacks Park upgrade - text on thumb drive.

Segment Five: Short Story – RCP** - prompt via tablet. Pre-programmed text on thumb drive.

Segment Six: Music Video*** - prompt via tablet. (See video clip on Youtube URL on thumb drive).

Segment Seven: 3D Avatar for VRChat - prompt via tablet. Image on thumb drive (see next page).

Segment Eight: Thank Yous and Credits via Text on thumb drive.

* Segment Two Prompt - 50th Anniversary of Garland Park. On June 19, 1976, the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District opened the Garland Ranch Regional Park. The park district acquired the Garland ranch in March 1975 from William May Garland II for \$1.1 million, along with a \$250,000 gift from Garland.

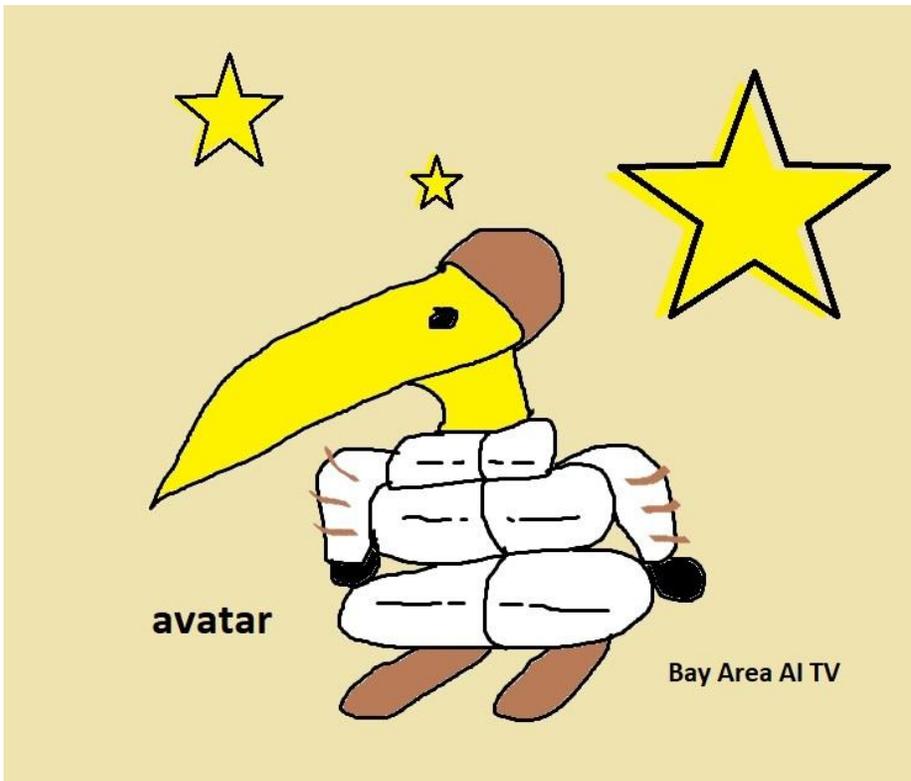
